“Wake-Up People” spoofs

Kids falling asleep at school, while driving, and at church

Use video clips of professional football coaches making statements, but we input our own questions to make it sound like they are saying missing DNow would be a really bad idea. (Larry Franks has some of them mostly put together, we would just need to change the questions.)

Larry to contact video guy and email us to come and do a quick video shoot to put in videos

Wednesday Night Kick-Off – Awake

Make it upbeat

Decorate the stage with beds, sleeping bags, cots, etc.

When teens come in the stage will be “dark”

Several minutes before we get “started” we’ll play a video of a teen doing/checking off a list of boring Christian activities (Don’t do drugs, Be nice, Go to church, Obey parents, Listen to Christian music, Wear a Christian shirt, Pray, Read the Bible). As the teens works his way through the list, we’ll try to make it as boring as possible. Then, when he gets to the last one he’ll fall asleep.

A snoring noise will play

Fee will be “asleep in the beds and cots

At start time, we’ll have a video of all kinds of alarms going off for about 30 seconds (while Fee gets up and gets ready)

As soon as Fee is ready (and while the alarms are still going), they will just kick it into high gear. When Fee kicks it in, we’ll fade the alarms.

Saturday Night – Engage

Make the evening much more of a “worshipful” atmosphere

Simple stage with candles

Ask teens to come in quietly

Have a video that contrasts the “boring Christianity” video

Use a video opportunities of places where God is working and moving (e.g. Life of Worship from Worship House)
